

SHANG INSCRIPTION ON BONE. The characters are to be read from top to bottom, but the lines in this particular case read from left to right. The meaning of the text is: "[On the day] hsin-mao, it is divined whether on this hsin day it will rain—or not rain." Most of the characters in this text are clearly identifiable from their modern forms. The second character in the second column is a picture of the sun with a spot in it, while the second character in the third column as well as the lower right-hand character show rain falling from a cloud. The upper right-hand character, showing a man's armpits (the two spots under the arms), was at this time a homophone for the undepictable word "also."
